Stop Loss Renewal:

There was a review of the stop loss renewal for FY25.

Joe Anderson said that the stop loss renewal has come in the loss ratio for Stop Loss has been hovering between 80 and 90%. HM has been the carrier with Stop Loss Insurance Brokers as the broker for the last five years. They were aquired by HUB International. Recently there was an increase by BHG in the specific deductible from \$250,000 to \$275,000. That is a good level for this group. There were two responses, One from HUB and one from Blue Cross. The increase for HUB was 13.9% and Blue Cross was 13.4%. There were no lasers for either group. Blue Cross discounted the administrative fees on medical by \$31,392 and zero percent commissions.

The third party broker currently is on the monthly warrant and reimbursements can take some time. With Blue Cross as broker, the reimbursements would be credited on the monthly invoice with fewer moving parts. Blue Cross would also take the eligibility that the group had already established since they are the sole carrier. The additional specific deductible illustrations of \$300,000 and \$325,00 were also looked at but Gallagher did not think that it makes sense to change at this time. Compared to other groups, the renewal was reasonable at 13%.

Erika Snyder motioned to approve BCBS as the carrier for Stop Loss for FY25 at 13.4% increase and total spend of \$ 1,259,500.
